It was Christmas, 32 years ago, and we had just finished doing the Christmas musical "The Greatest Gift of All" at an orphanage in the former Soviet Union. As

always...the director of the orphanage had told us when we arrived, **"Christmas is the most difficult time of the year for these kids....thank you for coming...."**

everything an orphan **DOES NOT** have.

As we seek to fund the efforts for our teams to go into the orphanages beginning the first weekend in December through January, we seek to use this time of year --- Christmas --- to share Jesus' love, tell the orphans the Good News of Jesus coming to earth, born in a lowly manger, in order to give them a family --
