"Three years ago, on March 31, 2022, (one month after the invasion began) the Ukrainian Armed Forces liberated Bucha — revealing Russia's true face to the world.

"Patriots tortured in basements, cars with entire families executed, civilians' bodies left on the streets. These scenes of deliberate genocide against Ukrainians must never be forgotten.

"But Ukrainians pushed this evil out. We remember how Ukrainian soldiers expelled the Russians from Bucha, Irpin, Borodyanka — from the entire Kyiv region — and later from the Sumy, Chernihiv and Kharkiv regions.

"Russia was defeated then. Russia will be defeated again."

As you know, we are honored and blessed to be serving 20 orphanages across war-torn Ukraine, and currently six of those orphanages are in the Chernigov region...one is in the city of Chernigov and is the largest orphanage with which we work (250 CHILDREN TOTAL THERE).
